- *How can we be more nurturing of novices while also motivating them to develop these creative networks in their own writing?*

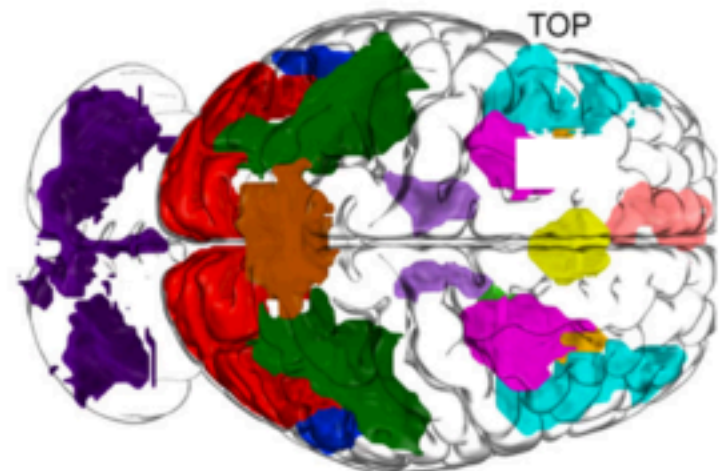
*Practicing digital forms does not in and of itself short-circuit creativity.*
